* NOTE: Our calories are given using the industry-standard Modified Atwater (i.e., Metabolizable Energy) equation, which assumes that pet food is 90% as digestible as human food. However, we believe that Evermore is a fully digestible food, and therefore feel that the Atwater calculation (i.e., gross calories, which is what the USDA uses to calculate human food calories) should be considered as well. These numbers are 1,203 kcal/kg., 546 kcal/lb., and 34 kcal/oz AS FED, and 4,529 kcal/kg., 2,054 kcal/lb., and 128 DRY MATTER.
